IV Edition Forum SusChem – Sustainable Chemistry, Innovative and Competitive Companies

Under the motto '*Innovative Chemistry for a Sustainable Future*'

- IV Forum SCICC will take place in Zaragoza (Spain) on March 1-2, 2017.
- It will present success stories based on innovations in sustainable chemistry whose processes allow delve into circular economy key issues such as the use of products and waste, and greater resource efficiency.

Madrid, May, 24 2016 • Under the motto '*Innovative Chemistry for a Sustainable Future*', the Spanish Technological Platform for Sustainable Chemistry – SusChem España organizes the fourth edition of the **Forum Sustainable Chemistry, Innovative and Competitive Companies (IV Forum SCICC)**, an international meeting aimed to debate and share information on new chemical products, processes and applications ever more efficient, safe and environmentally friendly. **IV Forum SCICC will take place in Zaragoza (Spain) on March, 1-2, 2017.**

On December 2015 the European Commission adopted a package of new measures on circular economy, aiming to help European businesses and consumers in the transition to a stronger economy where resources are used in a more sustainable way. The adopted measures are related particularly to eco-design, plastics strategy, reducing agricultural and food waste, secondary raw materials, reducing marine debris, and water treatment and reuse.

The chemical industry has a decisive role in providing materials and technologies that allow implement these EC standards and create a more viable future.

IV Forum SusChem will present success stories based on innovations in sustainable chemistry, whose processes allow delve into circular economy key issues such as the use of products and waste, and greater resource efficiency. Composites and multilayer plastics recycling; marine debris use; agricultural waste as basis for innovative products; daily use products based on byproducts from the food industry; or the state of the art for competitive water treatment and reuse, will be among the issues addressed.
